

Dear Quarry Tour Registrant:

Thank you for joining us for a tour of one of Elmhurst's favorite spots: the quarry! Here is some information to help you plan your visit to DuPage County's Elmhurst Quarry Flood Control Facility:

- Your tour bus will leave promptly at the time indicated on your confirmation email. **Please plan to arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled tour time.** The tour departs from the Elmhurst History Museum. We expect all tours to be sold-out. If you arrive after your designated tour time, we cannot guarantee your entry to a tour.
- **Free parking is available** at the Elmhurst History Museum parking spaces, and the Adelaide St. Parking Deck, a few steps west of York Street. Vehicles may be parked in the 3-Hour Parking area and Permit Parking area (which is open for public parking on Saturdays and Sundays).
- **Prior to joining the tour, all visitors must sign and submit a waiver. No one will be admitted on the tour without a signed waiver on file.** The waiver can be found on our web site at [www.elmhursthhistory.org](http://www.elmhursthhistory.org) in the Special Events section. Please download and complete the waiver, and bring it with you on the day of the tour.
- Some of the tour will take place in the bus, and the rest on foot with standing and walking needed. Visitors may need to walk on uneven terrain. - As some of the tour will be conducted outdoors, **we suggest visitors wear comfortable clothes and walking shoes and be prepared for the elements.** Feel free to bring your camera along as photography is welcome.
- **The tour will last approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.** After your tour, you are invited to visit the Elmhurst History Museum following the quarry tour for a self-guided tour of the *By All Accounts: The Story of Elmhurst* exhibit and to view a brief film about the quarry and its history. The Museum will open early at 9:00 a.m. for tour participants. Admission is free.
- **The tour will proceed in rain or shine. In the event of severe weather**, we will announce on our web site and Facebook ([www.facebook.com/ElmhurstHistoryMuseum](http://www.facebook.com/ElmhurstHistoryMuseum)) if the tour is cancelled. If it is cancelled, we will send an email to participants and call those without email. You will receive further information regarding refunds if the tour is cancelled.
