### 2019 RUTH STRAND POSTER CONTEST RULES & INFORMATION

Each year the Elmhurst Heritage Foundation sponsors the Ruth Strand Poster Contest in recognition of Ruth Strand, a long-time director of the Elmhurst Public Library and founding member of the Elmhurst History Museum, for her extensive contributions to the Elmhurst community. Rules for entries are as follows:

- **Second grade Elmhurst school students** studying Elmhurst history are eligible to enter the poster contest.
- Prizes will be awarded for first, second, and third place. There is also an honorable mention award given to a participant from each participating school.
- To participate, each student must draw a picture of a historical place or event in Elmhurst. They are asked to write a sentence or two to tell why that place or event is important to Elmhurst history. Students' entries will be judged on originality, quality and artistic expression.
- **ONE poster per student. ONLY use 8.5" x 11" form on reverse side.**
- Entries for the poster contest must be received by Elmhurst History Museum, 120 E. Park Ave., by 5 p.m. on **Friday, May 3, 2019.**
- Contest winners will receive a City Centre gift certificate and other prizes, and they will be invited to participate in the Elmhurst Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 27, 2019.
- Winning posters from each school will be recognized at an awards ceremony and reception on Wednesday, May 22, 2019 at 4 p.m. at the Elmhurst History Museum.
- Winners are invited to be recognized by the Elmhurst City Council on Monday, June 3, 2019.
